Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of Reading and RE, the children will be visiting The Hive Library and Worcester Cathedral on 21<sup>st</sup> May 2026. **We will wear school uniform and comfortable walking shoes/ trainers.**

We have a free workshop on how to use a library, we will then eat lunch at the Hive. Afterwards we will walk through the pedestrianised area of Worcester city and cross at the Pelican crossing to reach the cathedral. We will explore the cathedral and then complete an animal safari looking for all the stone animals. The cathedral will be busy and there may be a concert going on. We will get back on the coach at the back of the cathedral and will need to cross one road to get to it.

**Children will need to arrive promptly at school for 8.40 am** as we will be leaving school promptly at 9.15 am and will return at 3.00 pm.

On the day, the additional items your child will need to bring are:

- A packed lunch to eat (unless they are eligible for FSM) and at least 2 drinks.
- A rucksack to carry their lunch.
- A waterproof coat and a reflective jacket if they have one.
- Wearing sunscreen

The cost of the visit is £6.32, this will cover the coach cost. The workshop at The Hive is free and admission to the cathedral is free.
